This has been an extraordinarily active quarter for SPARC

The relocation committee has met with City and Chamber of Commerce officials, and is trying to identify and secure a new station location. Thanks also to those SPARC members that took the initiative to contact potential host organizations as we continue to look for a permanent station location in St. Pete.

The W4GAC-W4TA equipment was systematically dismantled and placed in storage by: W1AAG, KP2N, N2ESP, KJ4RUS, KR4U, KI4UIP, N4KII, and W4CU.

A big debt of gratitude to those that participated in our antenna party to remove the antennas installed on the Salvation Army building. In addition to those mentioned above were KJ4EXM, N4NSS, AL4B, W4NHQ, KI4TWQ and W1EES. Much of the equipment that was surplus to our needs was sold at TARCFEST, helping to fatten our treasury, and was less that had to be moved.

While the search for a permanent station location continues, the station equipment has been stored and a small station set up at the Clearwater Sail and Power Squadron on Cleveland Street. W4GAC Station Activities by David KR4U W4GAC Trustee

As of May 31, 2013 our club officially ended any connection with The Salvation Army in Saint Petersburg. All of our station equipment and the other items we had in the radio room have been moved to The Clearwater Sail and Power Squadron. This was a huge task requiring many hours of working and planning. I would like to express my heartfelt THANKS to everyone who participated to make it happen.

We have a very nice radio room in our new location and it does not require us to store less used items, we have a seperate storage area located upstairs in the facility. The radio room is located on the ground floor. Our next task will be to install a multiband vertical on the flat roof of the building and run the necessary feedlines and install a station ground. This effort will be started as soon as possible. This antenna will serve two stations one for W4GAC and the other for the power squadron club of which Tom W4CU is the coach. In addition our multiband dipole may also be installed. This setup will at least allow W4GAC to be active with one station on many bands. This installation will remain until any other possible locations in Saint Petersburg have been found and/or approved for a permanent home. Should this not happen after a reasonable time we can continue the station installation and install all of our remaining equipment and antennas as a permanent home.

Since we now have a SPARC Contest Group under the call W4TA I would like to explain how W4GAC/W4TA will be utilized. As you know we participate in several major contest events each year. In these contests we will use W4TA under which Bob N2ESP is the trustee. The only exception to this contest plan occurs when it is desired to participate in any Ten-Ten activities, for such events W4GAC will be used. I have just renewed our 10-10 number for another three years. If any SPARC members are active in the 10-10 program and would like to use the station please contact WA4EEZ, N2ESP or myself. W4GAC will also be used for any special event activities or non contest events.

I hope this information brings our membership up to speed on what has been happening with our club station activities, until next time.
