The SPARC Club Station, W4GAC



Each month as our members arrive for our monthly meeting they enter the Red Cross Building through our club station door. I thought it may be of interest to our membership to know just what we have in our station and how it all comes together, so here we go. We actually have two HF stations which can be operational at the same time using band pass filters such as the ones we use at Field Day. We call these positions Radio 1 and Radio 2. The main radio, position 1, consists of a Yaesu Ft-920 connected through a Collins 30l-1 linear amplifier, a large swr/wattmeter and a high power MFJ antenna tuner. The amplifier and meter are currently on loan from Scotty N4RI. The tuner is on loan from Ron KP2N. Position 2 consists of a Kenwood TS-450S and a 200 watt MFJ antenna tuner/wattmeter. Each radio is powered by its own power supply.

On the wall next to radio 1 is the antenna switching panel. This allows each radio to be connected to any one of 6 hf antennas, independent of each other. You could have radio 1 on the beam and at the same time have radio 2 on the vertical. We currently have 4 hf antennas but could add 2 more in the future. Our current antennas are a multi band beam on the tower with rotor, a tri band vertical 15-20-30 meters, a 40 meter vertical, and a sloper for 30-40-80 meters.

In front of each radio position, mounted below the table top, are two computer keyboards on pull out drawers. These are connected to our two computers mounted under the table, one for each radio. The computers are used for logging and operating on radio teletype (RTTY) and other more modern soundcard modes such as PSK31. They can also be configured to actually control radio functions based on the software we are using at the time. We can operate all modes and the Yaesu FT-920 can also be used on six meters, an antenna for that band is in the works for 2007.

In addition to hf the station has transceivers for 2 meters, 220 mhz, and 440 mhz along with antennas for these frequency's. The far right side of the antenna panel has switches for the vhf/uhf antennas. These radios have their own power supply located under the table top.

I hope I have provided a little insight of our station for our membership. Please take a few moments to look the station over and feel free to ask any questions that you may have. I, along with Ron KP2N, will be happy to help you.
