Guest Operations... Excerpts from FCC 97.82

Recent FCC actions established expanded operating privileges and created a need for increased awareness of proper operating procedures relating to frequency allocations and emission modes. When and how we can operate is clearly spelled out in FCC Part 97.82. Check recent issues of QST.

Availability of license....When operating from your home QTH: Your license (original or photocopy) must be posted in your station or available for FCC inspection if in your possession.

When operation is away from your home QTH: The license (original or photocopy) of the HOST station must be posted or available for inspection...AND..YOUR license must also be in your possession!

How to sign: You must always sign with the call letters of the HOST station!

- (1) You must stay within the frequency and emission allocations of your grade of license if you and the host have like licenses, or yours is lower.
- (2) If your license is higher than your host..you sign the host's call followed by your call..i.e AA4YA operating at WN4xxx (an extra at a novice station) would sign..WN4xxx AA4YA operating. Thus AA4YA could operate legally without endangering WN4xxx (who is listed in the callbook as a Novice) The chart below shows you how to sign for any class of license.

Legend....A = Stay in your band and sign HOST station call.

B = Stay in your band and sign HOST station call..AND YOUR CALL!

Stay in your allocated band..don't BOOTLEG on a frequency assigned to your host! 73 and good operating Bill..AA4YA
